What Do I Need to File?

- Social Security number
- Driver's license or state ID number
- Information on your employment over the past 18 months including:
 - Employer names, addresses, and phone numbers
 - Dates of first and last day of work
 - Gross earnings (before taxes) during employment periods
 - Reason for separation
 - FEIN number (on your W2 or 1099 tax forms)
 - If you don't have a FEIN, use your employer details from your paystub
