



COVID-19 and Unemployment Michigan

Filing for and Receiving Benefits:

If you have become unemployed, you may qualify for unemployment insurance benefits. These benefits are intended to provide temporary income as you seek new employment or have been laid off during the COVID-19 crisis.

The claim for unemployment benefits begins the first week you are laid off. The amount of time you have to file a claim has been extended from 14 days from layoff, to 28 days from layoff. You must file your claim within the 28-day window.

Common Questions:

How Do I File?

- Go to Michigan.gov/UIA using the MiWAM portal (you will need to login or create an account)
- By phone **1-866-500-0017 Option 1** to inquire about and to file a claim

What Do I Need to File?

- Social security card
- State issued drivers license or ID card number or your MARVIN PIN (if you have one)
- The names and addresses of employers you worked for in the past 18 months, along with your quarterly gross earnings
- First/last date of employment with each employer
- Most recent employer's federal employer ID number (FEIN) and Employer account number (EAN)
- If you are not a US citizen or national, you will need your Alien Registration card and the expiration date of your work authorization
